What Is Household Hazardous Waste?

Any portion of a product used in your household that has a warning label on it.



Hazardous, Flammable, Caution, Warning, Danger, or Harmful If Swallowed.

Examples of such products are:

oil based paints, stains, varnish, pesticides,
weed killer, lawn chemicals, pool chemicals, solvents,
adhesives, Ni-Cad batteries, acids, antifreeze, transmission fluid
and brake fluid.

What Should I Do With My Hazardous Waste?

You should try to use the entire product for its intended purpose according to the manufacture's label. If you can't use the entire product, try giving it to a friend who can use it. The Lincoln County Transfer Station, located 3.5 miles west of Davenport on State Route 2, has a fixed facility to collect household hazardous wastes that you need to dispose of. This service is provided:

Tuesday Thursday & Saturday from 9:00a.m. till 5:00p.m.

The hazardous waste should be in it's original container.
