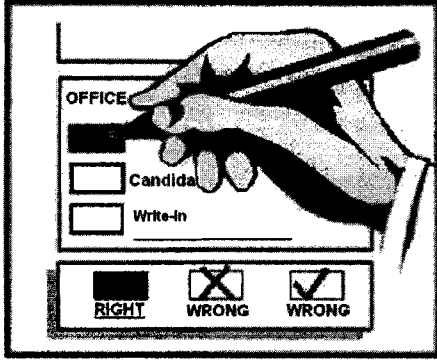

This proposition would authorize the district to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, upon all taxable property within the district, for support of the district's General Fund educational maintenance and operation expenses:

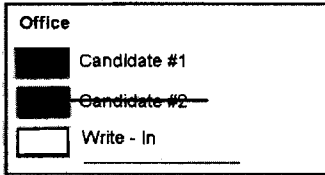

Replacement of Expiring One-Year Operation and Maintenance Levy

The Commission of Public Hospital District No. 1, Lincoln County, adopted Resolution No. 112008.03 concerning a proposition to finance operation and maintenance expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to maintain current levels of essential health care services by levying excess property taxes, in place of an expiring levy, at the estimated levy rate of \$1.03 per \$1,000 of assessed value upon all taxable property within the District for collection in 2010 to provide a total of \$163,500 for paying part of the District's operation and maintenance expenses, all as provided in Resolution No. 112008.03. Should this proposition be approved?
