SPRAGUE PAVEMENT PILOT PROJECT

Sealed Bids for construction of the Sprague Pavement Pilot Project will be received by City Sprague until 2:00 PM local time (as determined by the clock on the Clerk's office) on Tuesday, June 30, 2020. Bids may be hand delivered to City Hall: 119 W. 2nd Street, Sprague, WA 99032, or mailed to the mailing address of P.O. Box 264, Sprague, WA 99032. The postal service may not deliver bids mailed to the physical address set forth for hand-delivery of Bids. Any Bids received after the specified time and date will not be considered.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions on businesses, City Hall is not accessible to the public. However, bidders may deliver their bids in person by contacting the PROJECT REPRESENTATIVE and setting up a designated time where a member of the staff will receive the bid. Bidders may use alternative methods of delivery such as mail, package, or courier services, but the City will not accept bids arriving past the deadline of 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 30, 2020.

OPENING OF BIDS: The Bids will be opened and read at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 30, 2020, at the above-mentioned office of the City of Sprague. In order to promote social distancing, the bid opening will not be open to the public; however, interested bidders or member of the public may contact the PROJECT REPRESENTATIVE for details of how to follow the live reading of the bids. Comments and questions will not be accepted during the bid opening. Bid results will be posted on the project bidding website and provided upon request.

COMPLETION OF WORK: The Work must be completed within 30 working days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: This contract provides for the improvement of approximately 3,350 feet of roadway on H Street, 3rd Street, and a segment of 5th Street in Sprague, WA by constructing pavement full depth reclamation, hot mix asphalt (HMA), pavement markings, and other work, all in accordance with the Contract Plans, Contract Provisions, and the 2020 Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction. The project will include replacement of drywells, crosswalk striping, signing, and ADA improvements at curb returns.

OBTAINING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: Plans, specifications, addenda, and the bidders (plan holder) list for this project may be viewed online at <https://multisite.crweng.com/bidocs/>. Bidders must register with the PROJECT REPRESENTATIVE to be notified of addenda and new documents on this project. It is the Bidders responsibility to check for addenda and other new documents on-line. Plan sets will not be sold through the City of Sprague.

BIDS TO REMAIN OPEN: The Bidder shall guarantee the total Bid price for a period of 60 calendar days from the date of Bid opening.

All bid proposals must be on the form provided and must be accompanied by Bid security in the form of certified check, cashier's check, or Bid Bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid proposal. Should the successful Bidder fail to enter into the Agreement and furnish satisfactory performance and payment bonds within the time stated in the Contract Documents, the Bid Security shall be forfeited to the City of Sprague.

OWNERS RIGHTS RESERVED: The City of Sprague reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive informalities in the bidding process. The Agreement will be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder as it may best serve the interest of the City of Sprague.
